THAT Resolution No. B7a of the Capital Budget Committee minutes dated January 7, 2002 be rescinded; and further

THAT City Council approve the Retro Fit to the Civic Centre at a total estimated cost of \$5,635,000.00, as set out in Communication #284, being a report dated December 6, 2001 from the Parks and Recreation Department, as follows:

- in 2002 - replace Heat and Ventilation, estimated cost of \$1,200,000.00
- in 2003 - replace wood seats with theatre seats, estimated cost of \$483,000.00
- in 2005 - install State of the Art Sound System, estimated cost of \$312,000.00
- in 2006 - construct lobby expansion on south end, estimated cost of \$3,640,000; and

THAT the approval for replacing the sound system in 2005 be conditional on community fund raising and other level of governments contributing at least \$200,000.00; and further

THAT the approval for constructing the lobby expansion in 2006 be conditional on community fund raising and other levels of government contributing at least \$1,212,120.00.
